Types of proposals may include but are not limited to; hunting, fishing, camping and grazing. Proposals will be ranked based not only on revenue generated but also on the ability to provide proper management and conservation of the property. It is understood that the Commissioners Court of Llano County, Texas reserves the right to accept or reject any and/or all proposals as it shall deem to be in the best interest of Llano County. Receipt of any proposal, shall under no circumstances, obligate Llano County to accept the lowest price. The award of the contract shall be made to the responsible proposer whose proposal is determined to be the best evaluated proposal resulting from negotiation, taking into consideration the relative importance of price, reliability, quality and other Evaluative factors.

Proposals shall include this invitation to proposal and all additional documents submitted. No different or additional terms will become part of this contract with the exception of Change Orders executed by Llano County Commissioners' Court.

Successful proposer shall defend, indemnify and save harmless Llano County and all its officers, agents and employees from all suits, actions, or other claims of any character, name and description brought for or on account of any injuries or damages received or sustained by any person, persons, or property on account of any negligent act or fault of the successful proposer, or any agent, employee, subcontractor or supplier in the execution of, or performance under, any contract which may result from proposal award. Successful proposer shall pay any judgment with cost, which may be obtained, against Llano County growing out of such injury or damages.

Any injury or damages sustained by Llano County, its officers, agents, or employees arising from any negligent act or fault of said person(s) shall be the responsibility of Llano County and Llano County will indemnify and hold harmless successful proposer from the same.

Llano County shall pay any judgment with cost, which may be obtained against successful proposer and growing out of such injury or damages.

This contract shall remain in effect until contract expires, delivery/completion and acceptance of items and/or services ordered or terminated by either party with a thirty (30) day written notice prior to any cancellation. The successful proposer must state therein, the reasons for such cancellation. Llano County reserves the right to award-cancelled contract to the next best proposer as it deems to be in the best interest of the County.

Llano County reserves the right to enforce the performance of this contract in any manner prescribed by law or deemed to be in the best interest of the County in the event of breach or default of resulting contract award. Llano County reserves the right to terminate the contract immediately in the event the successful proposer fails to: 1) meet delivery or completion schedules, or 2) otherwise perform in accordance with the accepted proposal. Breach of contract or default authorizes the County to award to another proposer or purchase elsewhere.

The successful proposer shall not sell, assign, transfer or convey any contract resulting from this invitation to proposal, in whole or in part, without the prior written consent of Llano County.
