Rabies vaccines are available free of cost to Llano County residents who have been exposed to the virus. Possible Rabies exposure in Llano county should be reported. In addition, those at risk, such as animal control officers and veterinary personnel, qualify for pre-exposure vaccines.



Free Sexually Transmitted Infection Testing

Free and discrete screening tests for HIV, Syphilis, Hepatitis C, Gonorrhea, and Chlamydia are available for Llano County Residents (for non-residents testing is \$34).
